TonenGeneral Sekiyu K.K. and Tonen Chemical Corporation Kawasaki Refinery Hosts Students from Local Junior High School for On-site Learning Sessions

TonenGeneral Sekiyu K.K. (head office: Minato-ku, Tokyo; president: Jun Mutoh) and Tonen Chemical Corporation (head office: Minato-ku, Tokyo; president: Hiroyuki Yokota) welcomed six second-year students from nearby Nishi Nakahara Junior High School to their Kawasaki refinery (location: Kawasaki, Kanagawa; manager: Fumito Fujii) for on-site learning sessions on January 19.

The sessions, designed to provide opportunities for students from local junior high schools to learn about one facet of the workings of society through firsthand observation of local businesses, were held at the Kawasaki refinery for the first time last year.

The students gained basic knowledge of oil and also learned about the importance of safety and environmental protection in providing a stable supply of energy. At the conclusion of the sessions, they expressed their thoughts on the day's activities with comments such as, "Even if an emergency situation occurs, it's reassuring to know that the refinery goes to such lengths to maintain safety," "I'm glad I got to try putting out a fire. I normally wouldn't have a chance to do something like that. Now I know how to respond if there's a fire at my house," and "I learned what all these machines in the refinery are for."

The TonenGeneral Group believes that as a good corporate citizen, contributing to society while continuously working to maintain safety and health, protect the environment and respond to climate change issues is an important corporate responsibility. Holding on-site learning sessions for local junior high school students at its Kawasaki refinery is one of the Group's many social contribution activities.
