Wakayama Refinery Hosts Nursing Program Students for Practical Training

The Wakayama refinery (Arida City, Wakayama; manager: Eiji Kato) of Tonengeneral Sekiyu K.K. (head office: Minato-ku, Tokyo; representative: Jun Mutoh) held practical training for 10 students from the Wakayama Medical University Health and Nursing Sciences Masters Program on September 7. The training, implemented under the theme “learning about the current state of work environment management, work management and health management, and thinking about how to support the healthy lives of working people for the maintenance and promotion of their health and the prevention of work-related incidents”, was an opportunity for the students to learn about Tonengeneral’s initiatives for maintaining safety, health and the environment through discussion and on-site observation.
