## Large-scale Disaster Response Drill for Keihin Coastal Petroleum Complex Held at Kawasaki Refinery

A large-scale disaster response drill was held by the Keihin Coastal Petroleum Complex Extraordinary Disaster Regional Association at the Kawasaki refinery (Kawasaki-ku, Kawasaki City, Kanagawa; refinery manager: Fumito Fujii) of TonenGeneral Sekiyu K.K. (head office: Minato-ku, Tokyo; representative: Jun Mutoh) on November 30.

The drill, which is implemented annually to facilitate and strengthen cooperation between public institutions and private firefighting organizations in the event of emergencies in accordance with the Act on the Prevention of Disasters in Petroleum Industrial Complexes and Other Petroleum Facilities, has been held at the Kawasaki refinery every year since 2009.

Fifty-six participants, including those from the Kanagawa prefectural government, the Kawasaki Coast Guard, the Kawasaki City Harbor Fire Department, onshore and offshore joint disaster prevention organizations, and other companies in the petroleum complex, took part in the drill.

During the drill, which was based on a scenario involving a marine oil spill, oil tank leaks and fires resulting from an earthquake in the south Kanto region, seven marine vessels were used for offshore exercises including oil recovery, oil fence deployment, and spraying water to diffuse oil on the ocean's surface, while 22 firefighting and other vehicles were used in onshore exercises, such as soil piling, rescue and first aid operations, and simultaneous water discharge.
