## **Operational status**

- Our Kawasaki Refinery is in the process of resuming full operation of all facilities. In the meantime, we are maximizing our on-site power production to assist in supplying power to the Kanto area.
   Wakayama and Sakai Refineries are fully-operational and making exceptional efforts to support additional gasoline production.
- All our terminals are operating normally with the exception of Shiogama Terminal, in the Sendai area, which has suspended operations for the time being.
- We are making utmost efforts to assure stable supply to our service stations, especially in the
  affected areas, where operating conditions and inventories vary from station to station. We

## **Supply situation**
