### **One Million Liters of Fuel from Esso, Mobil and General Service Stations for Relief Efforts**

ExxonMobil Donates to Municipal Authorities in Tsunami-Stricken Areas

The ExxonMobil Japan Group will donate a total of one million liters of fuel to municipal authorities in Iwate, Miyagi and Fukushima prefectures, in the areas hardest-hit by the Great East Japan Earthquake Disaster of March 11.

Starting April 11, in addition to normal retail business, Esso, Mobil and General stations in these three prefectures will begin exchanging special fuel coupons in 10-liter denominations for gasoline, kerosene or diesel. The ExxonMobil Japan Group is providing the coupons to municipal authorities, who will in turn distribute the coupons to heat evacuation centers, maintain home-care services for the elderly, fuel construction vehicles, help affected residents, or meet other needs according to their own local priorities.

“The Great East Japan Earthquake Disaster has brought immense suffering and anxiety to the people in this area,” said Philippe Ducom, lead country manager of the ExxonMobil Japan Group. “Our companies, together with our independent Esso, Mobil and General dealers, have worked hard over the past few weeks to restore supply to Tohoku. But we want to do more. Together, we hope to make a positive difference in the daily lives of the tsunami victims through this donation of fuel.”
