Additional Rate Plans for Low-voltage Electric Power Retail Sales

TonenGeneral Sekiyu (head office: Minato-ku, Tokyo; president: Jun Mutoh, "TonenGeneral" herein) announces that it has decided to offer additional plans for low-voltage electric retail power sales in the Tokyo Electric Power Company service area, following the standard plan (fixed rate discount) announced on January 4, 2016, set to commence with full deregulation of the low-voltage power market in April 1, 2016.
