New Land Shipping Facility at Kawasaki Refinery

TonenGeneral Sekiyu K.K. (head office: Minato-ku, Tokyo; president: Jun Mutoh; "the company" herein) has been engaged in the construction of a new petroleum product land shipping facility (150 East tank truck terminal) at its Kawasaki refinery (location: Kawasaki City, Kanagawa; manager: Fumito Fujii; "the company" herein) in order to reinforce its system for the stable supply of products in the Tokyo metropolitan area and to strengthen its business continuity plans for response in the event of a disaster. The company announces the recent completion of construction and the commencement of fuel shipments from the new facility today.

In accordance with the intent of the government's Building National Resilience project as applied to the oil supply infrastructure, ground improvement measures to prevent liquefaction were implemented on the 150 East tank truck terminal site, and the facility itself, designed to withstand earthquakes occurring directly under the Tokyo metropolitan area and equipped with features such as independently-operating emergency power generators, is highly resistant to earthquakes. Shipping operations currently carried out at the refinery's Lot 200 tank truck terminal will gradually be transferred to the 150 East tank truck terminal.


The TonenGeneral Group will continue working to fulfill its mission of providing a stable supply of petroleum products, which support and enhance day-to-day life and the functioning of society.
