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2016 Entrance Ceremony Speech to Welcome New Employees (summary)

What we expect of you is to create added value by constantly pursuing opportunities for improvement, maintaining a sense of ownership in our organization and taking the initiative in all aspects of your work. From here on, keeping our mission and values in mind, you must always think not just about "how", but also "why" and "for what" in your day-to-day business operations.

Lastly, I would like to talk about the company-employee relationship sought by the Group. Today I have talked about the importance the Group places on safety, health and the environment as one of its central values. I have also talked about the importance the Group places on its employees, whom we consider to be our greatest assets. As you may be aware, the Company has been selected for the second consecutive year for the "KENKO KEIEI Brand" as a listed company with outstanding health and productivity management. We want to enable our staff to be highly productive in their work, with workplaces where employees can work vigorously and with a sense of purpose, and are in sound health both physically and mentally. We want to offer an environment where each employee can voluntarily work on health maintenance and improvement, and think about his or her health over the long term to live an abundant life. We want our employees to remain in good health even after retirement and look back positively on their careers. This is the kind of company we are striving to be.

In conclusion, all of you have chosen to work in the energy industry, and further, with our company. Likewise, each of you has been chosen by the Company through a rigorous selection process. The present and future of the Company depends on our most valuable assets, our employees. I encourage you to spread your wings as you embark on your new careers, and I anticipate great things from you.
